

Urban Craft Market at Derby Days // Next Steps for Food Vendors

Hello, Derby Days Food Vendors!

Below are important next steps that the City of Redmond is requiring to be **completed by June 5, 2026**:

1. Apply for Redmond's mobile food preparation vehicle [permit](#)

This is a requirement for food trucks/vehicles equipped with appliances that:

- Produce smoke or grease-laden vapors
- Utilize liquefied petroleum (LP) gas systems or compressed natural gas (CNG) systems

If you don't feel this permit applies to you, please reach out to FLS@redmond.gov and they will add you to the list of "No Permit Needed per Determination."

2. Apply for a King County temporary food [permit](#)

3. Send your Certificate of Insurance to us here in this same email thread, meeting the below requirements:

- The City of Redmond, its officers, volunteers, and agents must be listed as additionally insured with limits no less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. Endorsement attachments must be included.

- Dates of coverage to include the month of July 2026 at minimum
